The latest crop of design books to hit the shelves is an education for the eye and an essential addition to a connoisseur's library.

In *Out East* (Vendome, \$75), *Veranda* contributor Jennifer Ash Rudick traipses through retreats rustic and refined in that gilded enclave known as the Hamptons. The aptly named *Fabulous!* (Rizzoli, \$75) explores the imaginative oeuvre of Tom Britt's 50-year career. Richard Keith Langham's *About Decorating* (Rizzoli, \$60) mines the posh, polished take on American traditional that is his forte. *An Eye for Beauty* (Rizzoli, \$50) captures the hushed and soothing spaces that Beth Webb curates for her lucky clients. *Veranda's* former editor in chief Dara Caponigro and photographer Melanie Acevedo profile iconoclastic tastemakers in *The Authentics* (Clarkson Potter, \$60). *Second Bloom* (Vendome, \$35) celebrates Cathy Graham's inventive art of the table. Gil Schafer's *A Place to Call Home* (Rizzoli, \$55) honors the power of place in architecture. *Veranda: Inspired by Color* (Hearst Books, \$60) is our latest primer for living boldly.
